Improvements Around the Course



Big changes took place recently behind the 9th green at Alpine Lake Resort as the aging transformers on the utility pole were finally replaced. These transformers, which had been in service well past their expected lifespan, had aged to the point of failure and were no longer working. They supplied power to both the cart fueling station and the cart storage facility, making their replacement a top priority. The old pair was retired and replaced with a single modern transformer capable of handling the work of both previous units. This upgrade not only streamlines our power supply but also ensures reliable service for many seasons to come. With this improvement in place, our golf operations can continue running smoothly while keeping our carts fueled and ready for play.

This summer, Chester, JC, and the entire course maintenance crew have been working tirelessly to keep Alpine Lake Resort in great condition. From battling the challenges of an unusually wet early season to pushing through the heat of the later months, their dedication has never wavered. Every fairway mowed, bunker raked, and green rolled is a direct result of their hard work and commitment to making the course both beautiful and enjoyable for all who play it.
