*ASSUMING THE OUT-OF-STATE QUARANTINE ORDER IS LIFTED ON MAY 21 TO INCLUDE THOSE OUTSIDE OF WV

DAILY TEE TIMES FROM 8 AM TO 4 PM

Any player who is without symptoms of COVID-19 are able to play following these measures:

- Book online (coming soon) or by phone prior to arriving to reduce contact at the Clubhouse
- Call 304-789-2481 and enter 150 when the recording begins to be transferred to the Clubhouse
- Walk-ins are strongly discouraged but will be accommodated if tee-times are available
- Change shoes in the car parking lot and avoid the Clubhouse, or changing areas, whenever possible
- Masks or face coverings reduce the potential spread of an unknown carrier, masks are strongly encouraged for all players during check-in or any time at or around the Clubhouse
- Use social distancing (6-foot rule) on the putting green at ALL times
- Meet on the first tee with modified greetings at a distance
- Social distancing (6-foot rule) is mandated on tees, greens and throughout the rounds
- Carts will only be used by single individuals and cleaned afterwards. Carts may be shared with spouses or members who share a household.
- Golfers should only pick their own ball up
- Golfer should only handle their own scorecard only. A scorecard will be provided in your cart at the start of your game
- Bring own cooler with ice, towels and ball cleaners if needed. Beer, Pop and Snacks will be available at the Clubhouse.
- Club rentals are not available at this time
- Driving range procedures have been modified for sanitation and social distancing protocols
- Course bathrooms are open. Bathrooms are not available at the Clubhouse at this time
- Leave the flag in place while putting. Flags should not be touched by any golfer to comply with Covid-19 best practices
- Sort out the sand in the bunker with a club. Rakes will not be available to eliminate possible surface exposure during this crisis.
- Players should use hand sanitizer on the way round and at the end provided outside of the Clubhouse
- No handshakes on 18th green
- Avoid the Clubhouse, whenever possible
- Finish and go home!
